ACADEMIC SUPPORT SERVICES

LDAMV and RCIL's Academic Support Program is designed to provide support for individuals with learning disabilities, developmental disabilities and/or neurological impairments (including attention deficit, Tourettes and Aspergers Syndrome).

The program will begin on Wednesday, March 5 and run every Wednesday and Thursday from 4:30 to 6 pm. Sessions last approximately 90 minutes twice per week. If students need to arrive earlier, a staff member will work with the student until the teacher arrives.

The program targets students 14 to 21 years old and are currently struggling with specific classes. The tutor will develop instructional plans that focus on the specific needs of each individual student, thereby giving specialized support where the student needs the most attention.
